DREAM PROGRAM

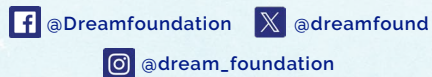

Dreams for Veterans fulfills final Dreams for terminally-ill U.S. military veterans, active service members, and members of the Reserve and National Guard.

REQUESTING A DREAM

Dream requests are as varied as those who make them. Whether it's a vacation or a new TV, a handshake from a personal hero or a hug from an old friend—each Dream recipient knows what will bring the greatest joy and relief to their situation, thereby providing inspiration, comfort and closure to them and their families.

Qualifications

Dream recipients are U.S. military veterans living in the United States, including Alaska, Hawaii and Puerto Rico. Aged 18 and older, they are diagnosed with a life-limiting illness with a life expectancy of one year or less and lack the resources to fulfill their Dream.

Proof of discharge or current U.S. military service is required, but applicants who cannot—or prefer not to—provide such documents are welcome to apply for a Dream through our general Dream Program.

YOUR APPLICATION

Our application process is simple. You can apply online at www.dreamsforveterans.org, where you'll find all the information you need about the application process, the kinds of Dreams we fulfill and answers to frequently asked questions.

We do not fulfill certain types of Dreams

- Requests for adults with chronic illnesses, unless they are in their last year of life
- Requests from individuals living outside of the United States and Puerto Rico
- Surprise Dreams
- Reimbursements for completed Dreams
- Legal assistance
- Automobiles, lifts, repairs, and RV/car rentals
- Hunting
- Property and home improvements or repairs
- Funeral arrangements or posthumous requests
- Travel outside of the U.S. and Puerto Rico*
- Medical treatment/supplies/equipment/transportation or dental extractions
- Cruises
- Any Dream request deemed offensive, inappropriate or inconsistent with Dream Foundation values or those of our corporate sponsors

**On a case-by-case basis we may allow one-way travel outside of the U.S. and Puerto Rico for patients who wish to die at home.*
